The phrases of Hildegard's chant have each been taken as a source for one variation, as follows:

- Theme: Spiritus Sanctus vivificans vita movens omnia et radix est -- Holy Spirit, the quickener of life, the motivator of all things, the root
- Var 1: Spiritus Sanctus vivificans vita movens omnia -- Holy Spirit, living & life-giving, the life that's all things moving
- Var 2: et radix est in omnia creatura -- the root in all created being
- Var 3: ac omnia de inmundicia abluit tergens crimina -- of filth and muck it washes all clean, wiping away guilty stains
- Var 4: ac ungit vulnera et sic est fulgens laudabilis vita -- healing our wounds, is our true life luminous and wonderful
- Var 5: suscitans et resuscitans omnia -- rousing and awakening everything

I believe that religions are like different languages, each capable of expressing profound truths, and often the same truths in different ways. Hildegard lived in 12th century Europe. She was given to a convent as a child and matured there into a mystic, a healer, and a composer. Institutional religion was all she knew, it was her language. To me, her words convey a sense of the mystery of life, a wonder, and an awareness of the healing powers of Nature.
